- I understand and accept that no participation in any dive courses or activities is allowed if I use any drugs or alcohol or if I don't feel generally well.
- I oblige myself to cover all costs of potential dive related accidents and accidents that may occur on the dive vessel including hospitalization, medical treatment, transportation and evacuation.
- In the event that I become incapable of making sound decisions I fully authorize the staff of Blue Planet Liveboards to take necessary actions for my safety and declare that I will cover all related expenses.
- I confirm that the staff from Blue Planet Liveboards have duly informed me of safety aspects of recreational scuba diving and I am prepared to follow these rules.
- I accept that while diving I must obey the instructions given to me by the Blue Planet Liveboards staff.
- I confirm that the staff from Blue Planet Liveboards have checked my logbook and diving certification.
- I accept that I must obey to the Safety Rules set up by Chamber of Diving and Water Sports and the Egyptian Law.
- I hereby declare that I am committed to leave the boat after ending the safari immediately, during the safari in case I am not committed to the boat rules and regulations and cause any harm or damage to divers, dive guides, crew member and boat i have to leave the boat immediately without objection.

#### Safety Rules

- Maximum recreational depth in the Red Sea is 40 metres (depends on the certification and experience).
- Deco Diving prohibited.
- Solo Diving prohibited.
- Safety stop should be made at the end of each dive at 5 m for 3 min.
- Lost buddy – search one min. Then ascent and reunite on the surface.
- Avoid dehydration – drink a lot of water.
- Finish diving 24 hours before flying.
